F. Parish Report

- Nick Winnike reported that Tim McClanahan will continue to host Monday morning work sessions in and around Noll Hall to clear out unneeded items and construct shelving in various spaces to create more useable storage for the parish ministries that the spaces are assigned to. The work sessions will run the next several weeks and be scheduled from 9-noon.
